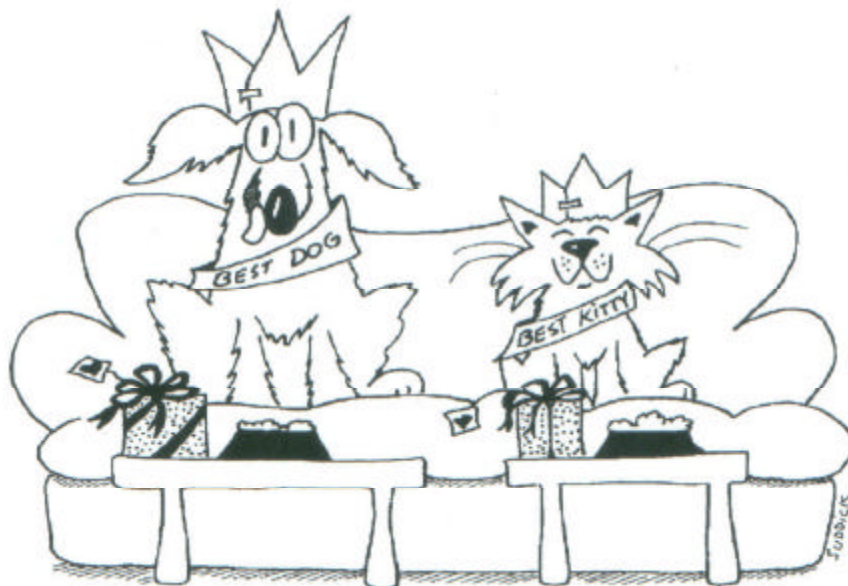


Be Kind To Animals Week®
